STUDENT MINISTRIES DIRECTOR'S INFORMATION

To whom this may concern,

Our goals at IHN Bible College is not only to educate Christian students of God's Word but to prepare them for work in the ministry of Jesus Christ our Lord. Since we offer our programs over the Internet as well as at our campuses it is important to establish a means of accountability to which the student will be held to. Since our own local church has taken on the responsibilities of directing our own students, and because of the distance between our worldwide student, we have developed this Student Ministries program to be part of any and all degree programs we offer.

It is important our students receive guidance from and be held accountable to their own local church or a church of their choosing. The student you received this information from is asking you or one of your staff/deacons/church leaders/etc. to be appointed as "Director" over the student's Student Ministry Program.

Below you will find details of the program and how you can help this student become a vital member of God's family. We are a non-denominational institution who promotes each student's denominational beliefs. This means you get to decide what the program is for this student and how the student will work within the bounds of your particular denominational beliefs.

Please remember this program must allow the student to take active parts both within the church and outside. There will be assignments where we will ask the Director to provide opportunities for the student to minister through an outreach program such as feeding the poor, working with the homeless, visiting orphans and widows, and other outreach ideas the Director may come up with.

There may also be times, due to the particular ministry concentration the student has chosen, where the student may be required to give a sermon, sit-in on a counseling session, lead in worship, or another in-church function of responsibility.

The student is required to work a minimum of two (2) hours per week on any project assigned to the student for that week. If you wish to assign more hours per week that is a good thing. This is an on-going, year-round program until the student completes the degree program he/she is enrolled in.

I wish to thank you personally for allowing us the opportunity to have this student learn from your church and its leaders. The future of this student's ministry will be largely guided by the work he/she does while in this program.
